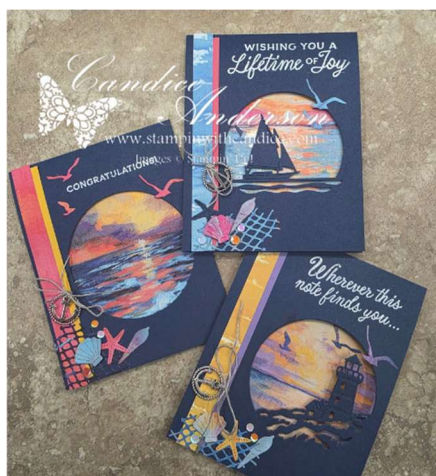

Designer Series Paper Cutting Guide



Measurements

Designer Series Paper – Your choice – Choose inside color to coordinate

- Cutting directions are with the water scene facing up
- Cut left side at 1/2" (use reverse side on front of card)
- Cut center to 3-3/4" (Inside fold)
 - Cut 1/2" off the top and the bottom so it is now 5"
 - Use to decorate interior of card
- The 1-3/4" Piece that is left will be used for die cutting

Night of Navy

- 4-1/4" x 11" – scored at 5-1/2" (Card Base)

Inside – Fun Fold section

- Light House – Highland Heather
- Sailboat – Strawberry Slush
- Ocean – Crushed curry
- 8" x 5-1/4" – Scored at 4" (inside card fold)
- 1/2" x 5-1/4" (front of card)

Basic White

- 3-1/4" x 5-1/2" (inside)

1. Preparing the card front which is the 4-1/4" x 11 Night of Navy piece folded at the top to open from the bottom.
 - a. Choose image you want to die cut from the three in the set – Lighthouse, Sailboat or Rays.
Note the Rays is what I used for the ocean card as it fully cuts out the circle.
 - b. Stamp your desired greeting on the top right section of the card, in versa mark ink and emboss with white embossing powder.
 - c. Place die about 1" from the bottom and about 1/4" from the right side. Make sure your card is open before cutting with the cut and emboss machine.
2. Attach the 8" x 5-1/4" piece folded at 4" to the inside of the card – centering it with the fold on the left side.
3. Attach the 3-3/4" x 5" designer series paper to the front of the inside card piece 8 x 5-1/4 scored and folded at 4".
4. Cut other images from the 1-3/4" Designer series paper.
 - a. I cut 2 sets of seashells and 2 sets of birds for most cards.
 - b. Remember you can turn the paper over to get the other design for more variety.
 - c. I also cut two of the netting. You can cut one from the cut out image from the sailboat or the light house to get a Night of Navy netting if desired. You only need a portion of the netting so don't worry when you can't cut the full image.
 - d. What you cut will depend on the designer series paper you choose as the die you choose. There should be plenty of paper as I was able to cut out extras while designing it.
5. Decorate the front of the card.
 - a. Attach the 1/2" x 5-1/4" piece from the inside card to the 1/2" Designer series paper leaving about a 1/8" showing.
 - b. Tie linen thread around the two pieces and attach the Anchor Trinket finishing by tying a large bow.
 - c. Attach to the left side of the card. Trim top and bottom to fit card.
 - d. Attach netting and seashells. Pop up the large shell with a dimensional.
 - e. Attach birds. On some cards I attached the birds to the designer series paper on the inside.
6. Decorate the 3-1/4" x 4-1/2" piece for the interior of the card.
 - a. Stamp with desired saying in Night of Navy
 - b. Add one of the 1/2" Designer series paper that was cut off the center section – or use both.
 - c. Decorate with other pieces cut from the Designer Series Paper.
 - d. Trim as needed
 - e. Attach to interior of card – inside the 8 x 5-1/4" piece.

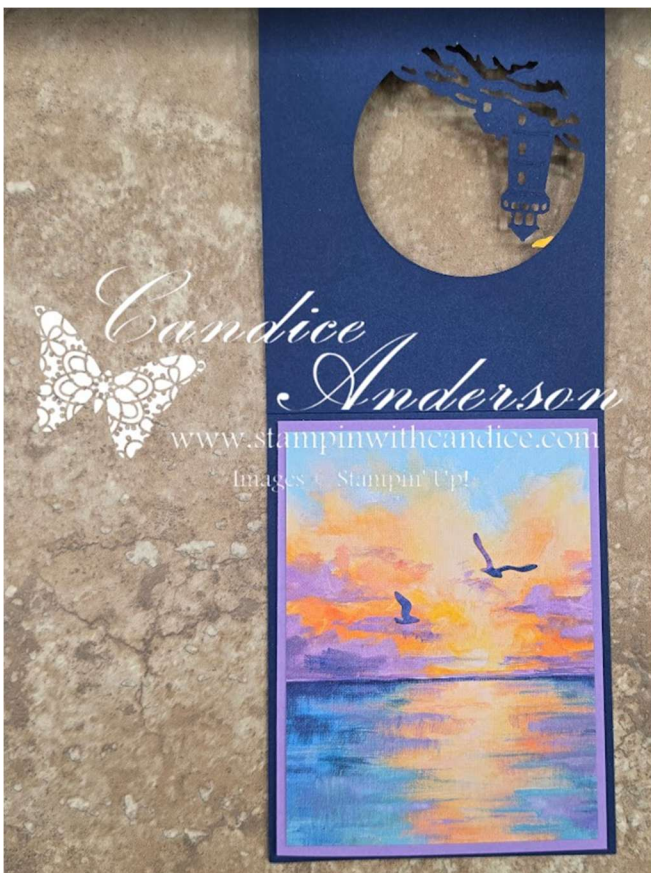
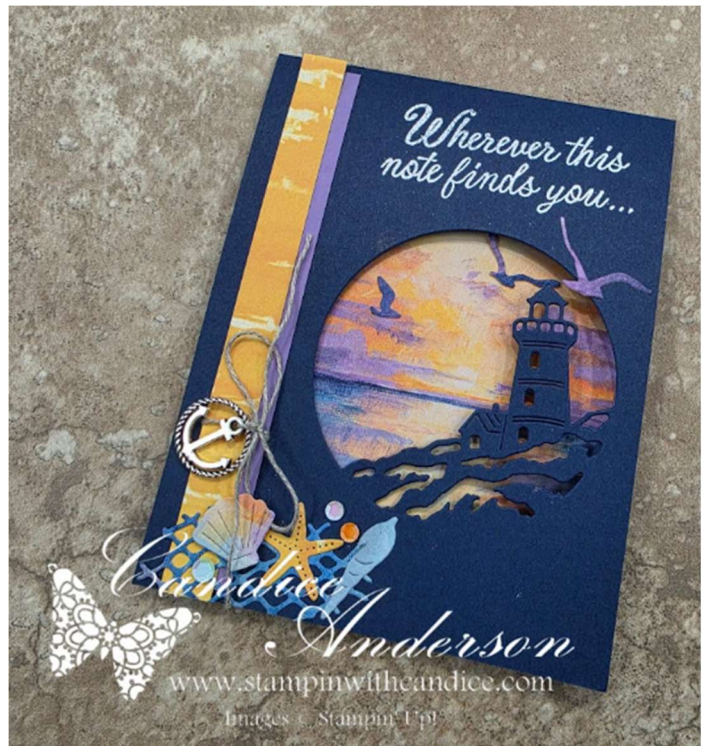
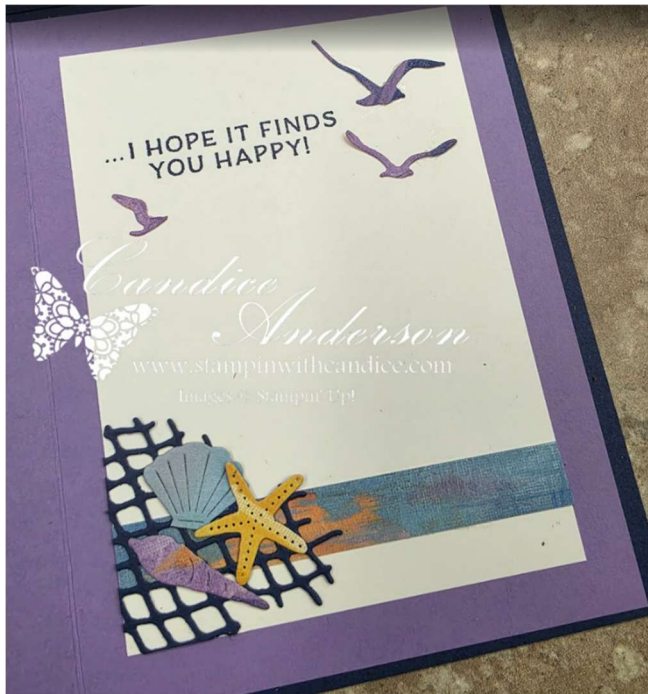
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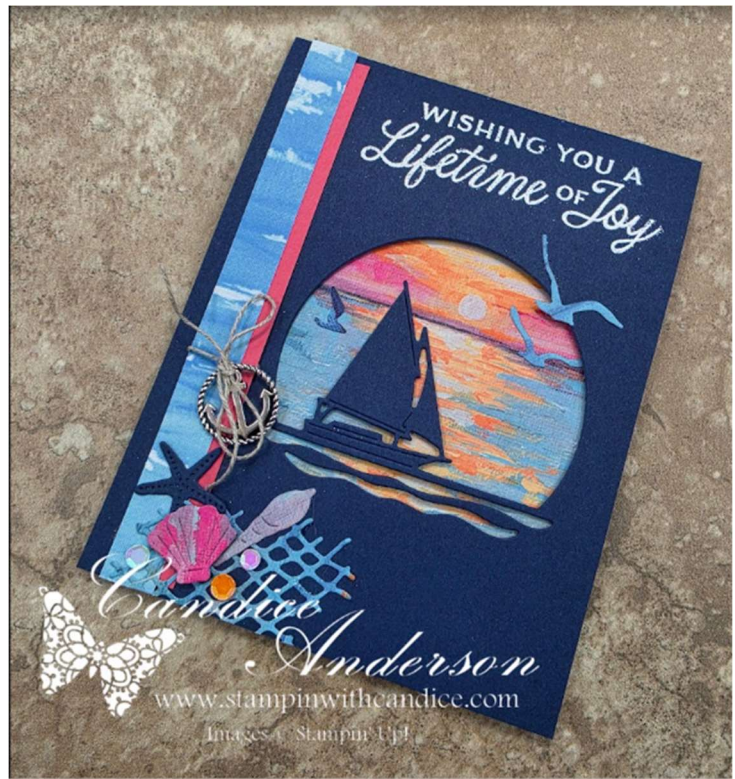
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Lighthouse Card
