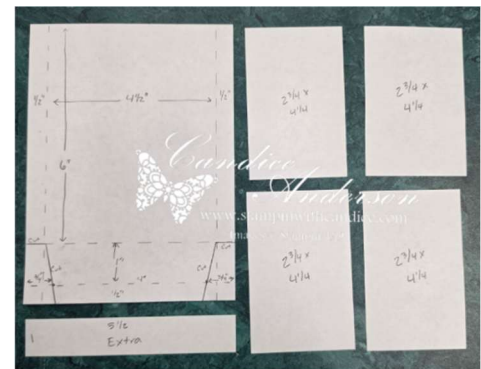

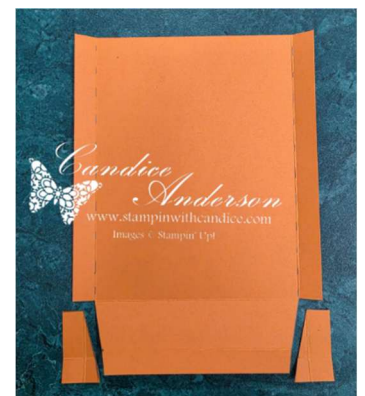


Measurements

Back Piece – Colored Cardstock

Start with an **8-1/2" x 11"** sheet and cut:

- **7-1/2" x 5-1/2"**
 - Score at **1/2"** along both **7-1/2"** sides.
 - On one **5-1/2"** side score at **1/2"** and **6"**.
 - On the **1/2"** score line, use a pencil to mark **3/4"** in from each side.
 - Cut at an angle from the edge to the 6" mark
 - **Cut at the 6" line 1/2" in**
- **4-1/4" x 2-3/4" – cut 4**
 - Die-cut into arches – 4 arches needed Use center portions to cut:
 - 2 each of the different tags
 - 4 "Boo" die-cuts
- **1" x 5-1/2"**
 - This is an extra piece and can be used for additional die-cuts.

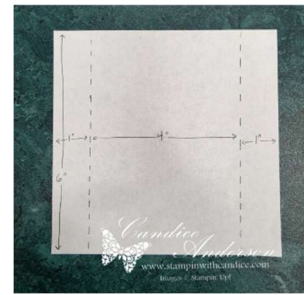


Tip: If you are not making all 4 boxes and using all of the cardstock colors, cut additional tags and "Boo" pieces from scraps in contrasting colors.

Spooktacular 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper

Choose one of the designs

- Score **1" from each side** of the monster face, leaving a **4" center section**.

1. Die-Cutting the Handles & Tags

Choose the **2nd and 4th largest Everyday Arches Dies**. Line them up so they are evenly spaced.

Place the dies on your cutting plate and tape the bottom section of the dies to the plate to keep the spacing consistent.

Slide one of the 4-1/4" x 2-3/4" cardstock pieces in from the top.

Place a tag die and the "Boo" die inside the center portion of the arches so you can cut several pieces at the same time.

Tip: Place the top cutting plate so it only covers the paper you are cutting. This will keep it from cutting through your tape and make it easier to keep the same measurements for each of the pieces.

Repeat until you have:

- 4 arches
- 2 tags of each style
- 4 "Boo" pieces

2. Prepare the Designer Series Paper

Fold the Spooktacular DSP along the **1/2" score lines**.

3. Prepare the Cardstock Back

Fold the cardstock along both side score lines.

Fold along the **6" score line** and the **1/2" score line at the bottom**.

Place Tear & Tape on the outside off:

- Both 1/2" side sections
- The 1/2" bottom section



4. Create the Handles

Glue two arches together using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, making sure the smooth sides are facing out.

Repeat with the remaining two arches to create the second handle.



5. Attach the First Handle

Use Mini Glue Dots along the bottom of one arch to attach it to the cardstock.

Center the handle between the score lines, leaving approximately **2-1/4"** of the arch **showing** above the cardstock.



6. Attach the Second Handle

Lay the DSP with the monster face toward the inside of the cardstock piece.

Position the second handle on the opposite side and use Mini Glue Dots to attach it, carefully lining it up with the first handle.



7. Assemble the Gift Box

Flip the DSP around then remove the Tear & Tape backing from the cardstock.

Carefully attach each side of the DSP to the cardstock.

Fold the bottom section in and secure it in place.



Note: The box is designed so the back is **1/2" wider than the front**, an angled shape that shows off the sides of the Designer Series Paper.

8. Create the Tag

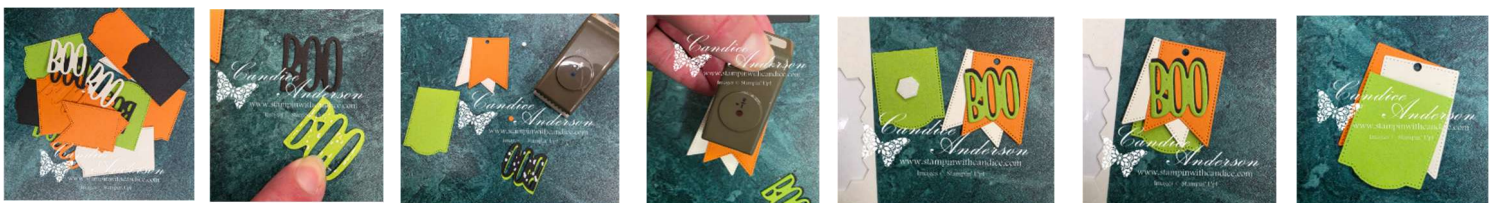
Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, layer two different colored "Boo" die-cuts together, slightly offsetting them to create a shadow effect.

Layer two different colors of the tag die-cuts and glue them together.

Punch a hole near the top of the tag.

Glue the layered "Boo" to the tag.

Attach the curved tag piece to the back using a Stampin' Dimensional. Make sure it is below the hole, trim down if needed.

9. Attach & Embellish the Tag

Cut approximately **12" of Baker's Twine**.

Thread the twine through the hole in the tag and set aside.

Cut approximately **4" of Iridescent Ribbon**.

To create the wispy ribbon embellishment:

1. Find a loose thread at the end of the ribbon and gently pull it to begin unraveling the ribbon.
2. Unravel the ribbon about halfway.
3. Using the Baker's Twine tie the tag to one side of the front handle.
4. Place the partially unraveled ribbon centered in on the tag between the Baker's Twine and tie a large bow with the Baker's Twine.
5. Hold the center of the bow and finish unraveling the ribbon.
6. Trim to your desired length.



10. Add Embellishments

Add Adhesive-Backed Bats, Ghosts & Dots to the handle for a little extra Halloween fun.

11. Create Custom Tissue Paper

Use the Web of Fun stamps to create coordinating tissue paper.

Stamp:

- **Spider Web** – Black
- **Halloween** – Granny Apple Green
- **31** – Pumpkin Pie
- **Spider** – Gorgeous Grape

12. Finish the Gift Box

Gently crinkle the stamped tissue paper and tuck it into the top of your gift box.

Add a favorite Halloween treat or small gift and it's ready to give!
